

Wasting drugs is a normal part of hospital operations. This happens because a vial may contain more medication than recommended for a patient's needs.

At ABC hospital, nurses in the Orthopedics department document waste an average of two controlled substances per day. But one nurse wastes six times daily, a red flag for drug diversion.

Imprivata FairWarning Drug Diversion Intelligence monitors for individuals who consistently waste more doses than their peers, determined by analyzing 100% of Automated Dispensing Cabinet transactions and identifying peer groups based on patient population accessed.

Investigating this case further could reveal a medical professional who has been siphoning drugs for their own use, potentially preventing patients from access to medications that help them manage pain or other risks.
